Arriving within 8 miles of his objective, on the night of the 12/13<sup>th</sup>, he decided to attack the Post on the morning of the 13<sup>th</sup>. His arrangements for the attack were so well conceived, and so well executed that, with the loss of only one man and one horse killed, he accounted for the whole of the Turkish garrison, with the exception of the unwounded, mounted men who escaped. He brought back as prisoners the Austrian Lieutenant in command of the Post, and four wounded and thirty three unwounded prisoners, leaving six of the enemy dead on the scene of action. In carrying out the above operation Major Scott displayed the highest possible qualities of a leader of mounted troops. He has previously been mentioned in despatches for good work on the Gallipoli Peninsula.
